## What to expect during repairs:

Phase I: Refurbish the Castle's interior, power wash and stain exterior, removal of old equipment This phase has already begun and the goal is to complete this work sometime in late June 2013 if all the funds for this Phase are raised through adequate support from the community. Kids Castle will remain closed during this period. **Total funds needed:** \$150,000

## Phase II: Repair and replace surrounding equipment, expand play space

This phase begins in March 2014 with the replacement of equipment surrounding the castle structure. Equipment will be replaced with maintenance-free, nontoxic, recycled playground equipment designed by community children. A musical garden, an outdoor classroom, and a brick walkway with murals will be added. **Total funds needed: \$400,000, required by June 2014.** 

**Phase IIb:** This phase includes replacement of mulched grounds with continuous rubberized play surface. **Total funds needed:** \$100,000, required by June 2014.

## Phase III: Restrooms, pavilion, snack stand

The final phase includes construction of family-friendly bathrooms and a pavilion/snack stand. **Total funds needed:** \$100,000, required by March 2015.
